HOW CHALLENGING?

The Duke of Edinburgh Award is a personal development award, and the Expedition programme develops teamwork skills through a teamwork challenge. The challenge encourages participants to support each other and share tasks whilst travelling, navigating, camping, cooking, and dealing with stressors.

Teams get lost, experience bad weather, have medical issues. Days feel long and hard whilst travelling through remote, unfamiliar areas. The team plans their route, selects appropriate clothing and food then attend a training expedition before they are safe to walk unaccompanied by an adult on a final expedition.

Time and distance covered per day

BRONZE 10-12 Km

6 hours of planned activity. Through fields & farm land

SILVER 12-14 Km

7 hours of planned activity. Some uplands and hills

GOLD 13-18 Km

8 hours of planned activity. Remote valleys, hills and mountains

WHY USE AN APPROVED ACTIVITY PROVIDER?

SAFETY IS PARAMOUNT

Adventurous Horizons has been approved by The Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme. They ensure our programmes provide quality training, equipment, and safety supervision systems.

Providing Bronze and Silver for large numbers of teams would be a huge demand on schools: normally they lack the staff, technical expertise, safety qualifications, equipment and insurance required. We take most of the stress and administration out of providing the Expedition Section. On every expedition lots of little problems crop up and sometimes big ones too, even on Bronze in Summer. But our staff have the experience to cope – we'll go out in the rain and fog to find teams and have outdoor first aid qualifications and the experience to manage. All teams on all expeditions have GPS trackers and emergency smartphones and attend 2 hour first aid and emergency training.

We hope for the best but always plan for the worst.



SUPPORT FOR PARTICIPANTS, PARENTS AND SCHOOLS

We manage all aspects of the DofE expedition programme to make the job of school DofE manager as straightforward and stress-free as possible. This gives every participant the best experience and chance of success.

BUILDING THE ULTIMATE EXPEDITION PROGRAMME

We provide all aspects of a DofE expedition programme, from managing the initial planning and expedition training through to running the practice and qualifying expeditions themselves. We take care of everything from advising parents and handling the expedition reports to DofE paperwork. This helps make the job of school DofE manager as straightforward and stress-free as possible, and it should give parents more peace of mind.

During these school-based, one-day sessions, teams attend 3 sessions: Using a map to plan their route; Basic first aid; What clothing and food to pack.

PLANNING

We can train teams on weekdays or at weekends, either at your own school or at other venues.

Each team has their own trainer who teaches them practical skills: how to navigate, camp and keep themselves safe and well-nourished in an expedition setting.

The trainer also covers aspects of teamwork and personal development. At the end of the expedition, each trainer will de-brief their team and give them an action plan that is shared with the school for follow up.

Accredited Expedition Assessors remotely supervise this un-accompanied expedition, meeting students along the way to monitor their progress and welfare.

Teams are debriefed at the end of the expedition and the Assessor report produced. We supply a background research pack to each student which they can use to formulate their project and presentation.

During the training expedition, our instructors discuss ideas with students and help translate those into their final expedition aims and presentation theme. They can make their presentations to our Assessors or to the DofE manager back at school.

OUR EDUCATIONAL ETHOS

IN EVERYTHING AND EVERYONE

- Planning Day (in school) designed and led by teachers. Provides participants with enough information and time to prepare and bring correct clothing and food to enjoy their Training Expedition better.
- Provision of support packs, workbooks and videos for participants and parents. Encourage better preparation beforehand and review afterwards.
- Training Expedition is 80% training / 20% assessment and even our Qualifying Expedition is 30% training and 70% assessment.

- Map & compass: one between two participants on Bronze & Silver. One each on Gold.
